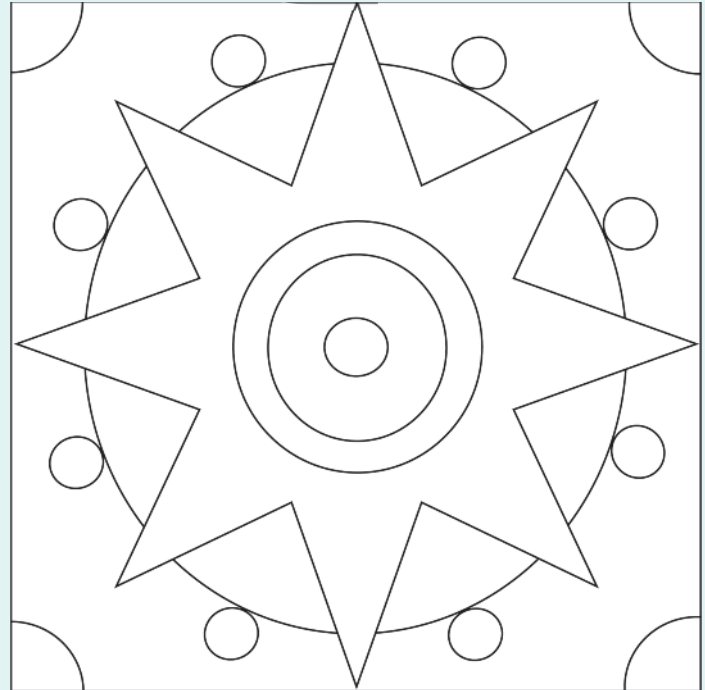

MUSSELS get their name from the Latin for 'little mouse' - because they're the same shape.



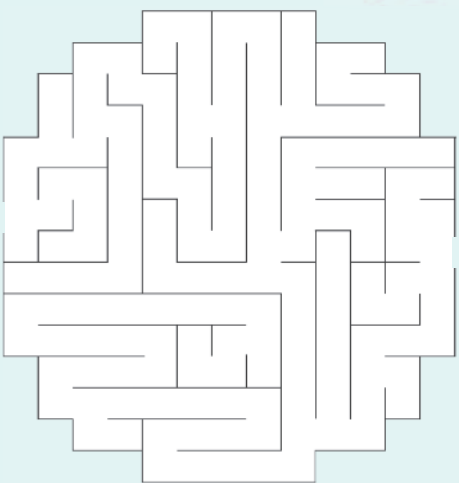
SCALLOPS have dozens of eyes, which help them to spot predators and decide whether to swim away or clam-up!
