1. Terms and Conditions

1.1 Photography, filming and recording inside the Shell Grotto for commercial purposes is strictly prohibited without prior written permission.

1.2 Personal photography is not licensed for publishing purposes.

1.3 You may not publish, use or distribute your photos for any commercial purpose, and you may not distribute or license to any third party.

1.4 You may not use flash, tripods, special lighting or protruding camera equipment such as large lenses or selfie sticks.

1.5 You must adhere to all additional on-site photography signage and rules.

1.6 You must take photographs in a way that does not cause any inconvenience to other visitors or put the Grotto at risk.

1.7 You are welcome to upload your photographs to your personal Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, and other social media with appropriate attribution to the Shell Grotto.

1.8 By uploading images or other content, including, without limitation, on social media, you grant The Shell Grotto Ltd a non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to share, publish, use, edit and manipulate that content anywhere, in any way, at any time.

1.9 We reserve the right to stop you taking photographs of the Grotto if we have any reason to believe that the images will be used beyond the terms of this policy.
